

The Columbus Academy Dress Code 2010-11

The Columbus Academy believes in a dress code so as to suggest a certain level of formality during the school day. The dress code attempts to balance comfort and individuality with consideration for community expectations. The table below outlines the dress code requirements, noting the different expectations for each of the three divisions. Because it is impossible for a set of defined expectations to cover all the vagaries about student choices and fashions, the determination about whether a student's attire complies with both the letter and the spirit of the dress code will belong to the faculty and administration.

<p><u>Polo Shirts</u> Solid color polo style shirts with collar, buttoned placket, short or full length sleeves (no cap sleeves), and free of any non-Columbus Academy lettering or logos. <p><u>Shoes</u> Solid color black, brown, or tan shoes, must cover the entire foot, remaining below the malleolus of the ankle. No boot style shoes. <p><u>Jewelry and Accessories</u></p>	<p>Boys and Girls: Students may wear a watch and one necklace that does not detract from the dress code and must be worn under the shirt. Barrettes, ponytail bands and headbands are to be simple and small, silver, gold, or Academy colors. Nail polish is not permitted.</p>	<p>Boys and Girls: Students may wear a watch and one necklace that does not detract from the dress code and must be worn under the shirt. No chokers. Students are not permitted to have extreme or unnatural hair color or to have visible tattoos or body piercings.</p> <p>Boys: Boys are not permitted to wear earrings during the academic day or when publicly representing the school.</p> <p>Girls: Girls may wear small stud earrings. Ribbons, ponytail bands, barrettes, and headbands should not detract from the dress code. Nail polish and make-up may not be worn.</p>	<p>Boys and Girls: Students are not permitted to have extreme or unnatural hair color or to have visible tattoos or body piercings.</p> <p>Boys: Boys are expected to be clean shaven and are not permitted to wear earrings during the academic day or when publicly representing the school.</p> <p>Girls: Girls are permitted to wear earrings.</p>
