



## Upper School Dance Permission Form

The Columbus Academy Student Council wishes to promote an atmosphere where all students feel comfortable both at school and at school-sponsored events. The Columbus Academy Student Council also wishes to protect the rights of all students.

Therefore, at school-sponsored dances, The Columbus Academy

- requires students and guests to arrive at the dance within the dance’s first hour.
- requires students and guests to sign in upon arrival at the dance.
- allows only ONE non-CA student guest\* per Columbus Academy student.
- prohibits dancing that promotes or demonstrates inappropriate sexual behavior.
- will not allow students to reenter dance after leaving.

\*Guests must have a signed permission form.

Failure to comply with these policies may result in dismissal from the dance.

Finally, the school reminds students that rules stated in the online Student Handbook apply at school-sponsored dances, especially those rules relating to drug/alcohol usage (Section V11, page 33) and actions that threaten other people (Section V11, page 34). The school would also like to emphasize that having a date is NOT a prerequisite for attending the dance, or to have a good time.

**What do kids wear to this dance?** Boys wear dress pants, dress shirt and tie. Most boys wear a jacket. Most girls wear nice dresses (gowns are not required).
