The Malone Grant, awarded to one or two new 9th or 10th graders each year, is designed to make a Columbus Academy education possible for students of the highest academic achievement and a clear enthusiasm for learning who might not otherwise be able to attend.

The Malone Grant covers tuition, fees and other expenses, with the amount based on a family's demonstrated need. Once the scholarship is awarded, it is renewed annually through the student's senior year.

A Part of the Regular Application Process

Acceptance to Columbus Academy is highly selective overall. Therefore, our decisions on Malone Scholarships are based primarily on the information in the basic application for admission with the addition of a brief essay. The Malone timeline, however, requires that all application materials, the student’s Personal Statement and the financial aid application be submitted by February 10.

We encourage all intellectually motivated 8th and 9th graders not currently enrolled to apply for the Malone Scholars Program. The Malone Scholarship is just one avenue for financial support for highly qualified students; applicants who are not selected as Malone Scholars are still considered for merit scholarships and regular financial aid.

In all, close to 20 percent of Columbus Academy students receive some level of need-based financial support. For the 2010-11 school year, Columbus Academy provided over \$1.8 million in regular tuition support—with an average award of \$10,000—as well as several merit scholarships.
