Special Notes

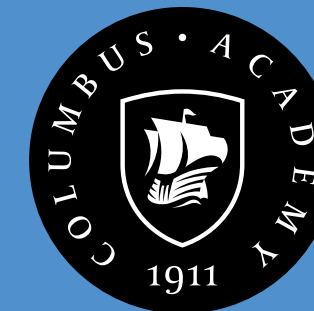
