Swim Lessons

Lacrosse

Grades: K-3 | \$100 (6 classes)

In this co-ed instructional lacrosse program, sessions will include 50% instruction and 50% game playtime. Participants will develop fundamentals of cradling, scooping, throwing, catching, passing, shooting, and the general rules of lacrosse in these highly active and engaging sessions. **Participants must provide their own lacrosse stick.** All other equipment will be provided.

LEGO Robot BattleBot Building and Programming

Grades: 3-6 | \$120 (6 classes)

Instructor: Robot Academy

Kids build and program LEGO Robots to compete in several BattleBot championships. Students learn to program BattleBots in the Mindstorms EV3 language using sensors and logic. Young engineers are introduced to mechanical design, programming and engineering concepts. No experience is necessary – we teach students everything they need to know to put together a winning BattleBot. Students in Girl Scouts will earn a STEM badge and Boy Scouts will earn the Robotics badge. Students do not need to be in Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts to take this class.

Gymnastics & Fitness

Chess Kings & Queens

Robotics Club

Building robots is a great way for students to develop critical thinking skills, grow their ideas, and make their own programmable creations. Students in this club will gain hands-on experience with Lego Mindstorms, littleBits and Sphero Robotics.
