# CAMPUS FACILITIES

## Hondros Field

After full funding from John and Linda Hondros and their children Morgan, Cody '00, Kelly '06 and Hobie '08, the Columbus Academy board of trustees voted to re-name the stadium Hondros Field. A \$1.25 million project completed by TurfFields in August 2014 replaced the stadium grass field with state-of-the-art artificial turf primarily used for football, lacrosse and soccer. The Hondros family's gift encouraged several other Academy families to give anonymously in order to fund a second all-weather field, which was installed on the west side of campus next to the existing field hockey and lacrosse area out at Carlin Fields. As a result, Columbus Academy became one of the few Central Ohio schools to have two all-weather surfaces for practices and competitions.



Hondros Field has since also served as a host site for several state tournaments during the fall and spring seasons. Hondros Field was officially dedicated on Sept. 5, 2014, at halftime of the Viking football game. The track surrounding the field, which was resurfaced in spring 2018, was also retained in memory of Mike Marsh.

## Carlin Fields

Dedicated in October 2016 in honor and memory of alumnus David P. Carlin '56, Carlin Fields plays host to Viking field hockey and tennis, and also contains several multipurpose fields used for lacrosse and other sports for games, practice and various activities on campus. David was a Board member and generous Academy benefactor as well as the driving force behind obtaining that property in the mid-1980s. His foresight into the potential importance of that additional space for the school's future use is further testament to his love and devotion to Columbus Academy. David's widow and other members of the Carlin Family (pictured) were on hand for the dedication and unveiling of the new archway welcoming Viking families and guests to the western portion of campus.



## "The Mack"

Named in honor of Columbus Academy's Headmaster from 1997-2013, The John Mackenzie Gymnasium, nicknamed The Mack, is the home court of the Viking boys and girls basketball teams, as well as the volleyball team. During his 16 years at the helm, John Mackenzie led CA through a period of growth and many accomplishments, including extensive enhancements to the curriculum, increased enrollment, aesthetic improvements to campus, the implementation of successful programs in the areas of diversity, technology, ethics and character, and creating a sense of community for all.



## Jones Gym

The Jones Gym primarily serves the Viking middle school basketball and volleyball teams, while also providing ample indoor practice space for outdoor sports during times of inclement weather throughout the fall and spring seasons. The gym is equipped with six basketball hoops, a full-size court and bleacher-style seating for guests and fans.



## James W. Stahl Field

Home field for the Viking baseball team, James W. Stahl Field was named after Academy's legendary baseball coach. In his 22 years at the helm of the Viking baseball program, Stahl compiled over 260 wins and won the Class A state title in 1982. A member of the CA and Ohio High School Baseball Coaches Association (OHSBCA) Hall of Fame, Stahl also led the Vikings to state runner-up honors in 1981 and the 1980 state semifinals. Coach Stahl also steered the program to a regional final and a pair of district finals over his tenure.



## Academy Swimming Pool

The Columbus Academy swimming pool is the official practice and competition site for the Viking swim teams. Several meets are held at the site throughout each season, including within the league, while also being used for competition throughout the year by the Greater Columbus Swim Team of Ohio (GCSTO).

# New Fieldhouse & Wellness Center

The success of Columbus Academy's athletic programs is booming, and so are participation numbers as well as the amount of offerings. Our athletics department currently fields 62 teams in 23 different sports for grades 7-12, and over 80 percent of students in those grades participate on at least one Viking team. There are also a growing number of parent-led youth teams for grades 4-6, so the CA gyms are almost in constant use from dusk to dawn, especially from late fall to early spring.

Discussions about an indoor fieldhouse have been taking place for years, but the much-needed project became a reality when a group of Academy families came together to offer a significant portion of the funding, thus relieving the school from undertaking a major philanthropic campaign.

The result will be an indoor multipurpose space big enough to contain three regulation basketball courts in addition to extra locker rooms, an expansion and reconfiguration of the current fitness room and an overhauling of all existing locker rooms.

Within the fieldhouse's 24,000 square feet will be 18 backboards and baskets suspended from the ceiling, a climbing wall next to stairs up to a mezzanine, a conference room and six offices for coaches. The flooring will be a top-of-the-line Mondo surface that professional teams use and team locker rooms will be refurbished.

A conference room and six offices that will look into the fieldhouse, along with an examining room, more taping tables, aqua-therapy, and a private office. Racks in the wellness center have been replaced with new state-of-the-art lifting equipment, along with more floor space and various aerobic machines.

## The OHSAA Believes That:

- Participation in interscholastic athletics programs is a privilege, not a right.
- Participation in interscholastic athletics programs complements a student's school experience and teaches lifelong lessons of hard work, teamwork and self-discipline.
- Participation in interscholastic athletics programs promotes citizenship and sporting behavior, instills a sense of community and promotes a lifetime appreciation for sports and healthy lifestyles.
- All students, regardless of ethnicity, race or gender, should have an equal opportunity to participate in interscholastic athletics programs.
- Sporting and ethical behavior are expectations in interscholastic athletics by all participants, coaches, administrators, officials and spectators.
- Coaches, administrators and contest officials should serve as positive role models who are critical to a student's development and success.
- In order to minimize health and safety risks and maintain ethical standards, it is mandatory that interscholastic athletics participants are free from use of anabolic steroids or other performance-enhancing drugs.
- All rules, regulations and facilities for and supervision of interscholastic athletics programs should ensure maximum protection of the health, safety and well-being of each participant.
- Limitations should be placed upon the length of sport seasons and the number of interscholastic contests played by participants.
- Students should engage in a well-rounded experience that encourages participation in a multitude of extracurricular activities.

- All attempts should be made to accommodate students with disabilities in interscholastic athletics programs.
- Compliance with all school, OHSAA and state regulations along with contest playing rules is essential for everyone involved in interscholastic athletics programs.
- Student academic achievement and success take priority over athletics achievement and success.
- The success of a team is more important than individual awards.
- Interscholastic athletics programs exist to prepare students for the next level of life, not the next level of sports.
- Participation in interscholastic athletics programs can be a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity and create memories that will last forever.

## Fan Fair Play Code

- I will remember that young people play sports for THEIR enjoyment.
- I will have realistic expectations and will understand that doing one's best is just as important as winning. I understand that ridiculing an athlete for making a mistake is not acceptable behavior.
- I will respect the official's decisions and will encourage others do the same.
- I will respect and show appreciation for the coaches and understand that they have given their time to provide sport activities for our young people.
- I will encourage athletes and coaches to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- I will show respect for my team's opponents because I realize there would be no game without them.
- I will not use bad language and will not harass athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators.
- I will always show good sportsmanship. Young people learn by example.

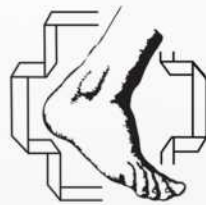
