

Dear Rising Grade 7 Families,

This letter is to inform you of the immunization requirements for students entering grade 7 in the state of Ohio. All seventh-graders will be required to have the addition of one dose of Tdap (**Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis**) as a booster to the initial series of required doses. Ohio is requiring the Tdap vaccine, as opposed to Td, to protect against Pertussis (whooping cough).

In addition to the TDAP, your child is also required to receive the Meningococcal vaccine prior to entry into grade 7. The Meningococcal vaccine prevents bacteria that is commonly spread from person to person, especially in teens and young adults. These bacteria can cause meningitis, which is an infection of the fluid and lining surrounding the brain and spinal cord, but can also enter the bloodstream causing sepsis.

Please contact your healthcare provider to schedule an appointment to receive the vaccines your child will need for the next school year.
