


# Google Classroom Crash Course


# **Accessing Google Classroom**

- There are only two "roles" in Google Classroom- Student and Teacher
  - o Parents/guardians can not directly login to Classroom due to privacy laws.

- Teachers can invite parents/guardians to receive "Guardian Summaries"
  - If you are not already receiving summary emails, you need to request an invitation from a teacher.
  - When a guardian accepts an invitation from one teacher, they are linked to their student in all classes.








# What is included in the parent/guardian summary?

- Guardian summary emails will show the following:
  - **Missing work**—Work not turned in when the summary was sent
  - **Upcoming work**—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)
  - Class activities—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers
  - Email summaries will **not** show current grades for the class
- You can click "View in Classroom" to view the material directly in Google Classroom.
  - It will not show you if your student turned the assignment in or not.



It will list a "quick view" of any current upcoming assignments.








To view all content. (HW, notes, assignments), your student should NOT look on the stream. but click on the "Classwork" tab.






