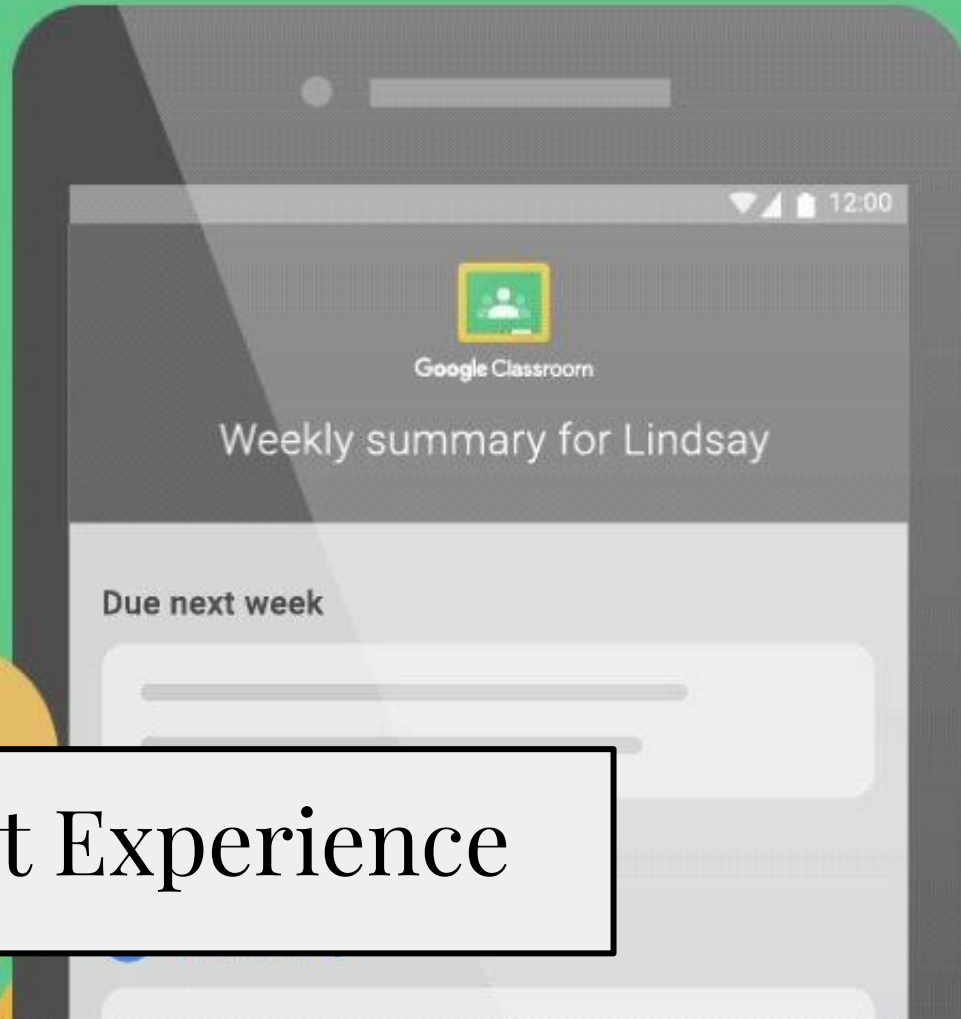

Google Classroom Crash Course

- What is Google Classroom?
 - Learning management system where students can access all content/materials (notes, class assignments, homework, etc.)
- The purpose of this session is to give an overview of Google Classroom, and how you can access it as a parent vs. a student.
- Balance of online and paper in classes



The Parent Experience

Accessing Google Classroom

- There are only two “roles” in Google Classroom– Student and Teacher
 - Parents/guardians can not directly login to Classroom due to privacy laws.
- Teachers can invite parents/guardians to receive “Guardian Summaries”
 - If you are not already receiving summary emails, you need to request an invitation from a teacher.
 - When a guardian accepts an invitation from one teacher, they are linked to their student in all classes.

What is included in the parent/guardian summary?

- Guardian summary emails will show the following:
 - **Missing work**—Work not turned in when the summary was sent
 - **Upcoming work**—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)
 - **Class activities**—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers
 - Email summaries will **not** show current grades for the class
- You can click “View in Classroom” to view the material directly in Google Classroom.
 - It will not show you if your student turned the assignment in or not.

To view all content (HW, notes, assignments), your student should NOT look on the stream, but click on the “Classwork” tab.

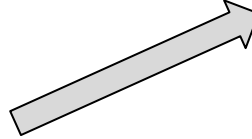
